## Old Business

Elkay Bottle Filling Station: Class of 2014 has provided funding for another station currently being installed between the weight room and the main gym. The Booster club will look into budgeting one for C wing in the 2015 budget. To be discussed at January meeting.

Presidents Bowl Basketball Tourney: Lance for an update from the Presidents Bowl Committee and Christine advised they had had their last meeting of the year and that the check presentation would be made on 2/24. Lance provide an update on the Presidents Bowl Basketball Tournament and reviewed the financial breakdown

- \$3,225 gate ( Saturday and Sunday)
- \$3,600 team registration fees
- \$6,825 RECEIVED
- \$2,200 PAID to the officials ( 37 games X 2 officials per game = 74 officiated games at \$30/game= \$2,200)
- \$4,625 TOTAL ( Less \$100 for gift certificate to Paul Seville if approved)

**Lance discussed the fact that the tournament was a "success" and we were very well positioned moving forward with the tournament at the Pentagon**

Presidents Bowl Volunteer Update- Rough draft will be sent out prior to the January meeting for discussion.

Membership- Membership is ahead of last year by 5 members and about \$1,000. We currently have 170 memberships.
