Principal's report:

Second semester is off to a good start even with some weather challenges. We are building great culture here at Roosevelt and part of that is the number of students involved in extracurricular activities. Attached is an information sheet providing additional information around the Sioux Falls public school calendar vote coming up on Tuesday, April 14,2015. He would like all the parent to have an informed voice during the vote. He also wanted to point out this only impacts Sioux Falls public schools only and not any other SD state school. A few important facts if the school year was pushed back to after labor day:

- 1. All athletic activities will still start at the same time (soccer 7 of 12 games would be completed; Football will have held 2-3 games before school starts if start is after Labor Day)
- 2. Marching Band would have 2-3 weeks less preparation time for their first competition
- 3. Students would have 3 weeks less preparation time for tests
 - ACT/SAT and AP tests are set Nationwide- also leaving the AP students roughly 3 weeks after their AP test before the semester is complete
 - Dakota Step testing stays the same
