Activities Director report:

Girls Softball placed first at state too. Girls and boys basketball starting off their season for fall sports. Five boys and five girls from RHS are on the All Conference soccer team- Great Job!

Treasurer Report

Special requests were paid out to both boys and girls soccer along with membership blankets for next year and the HUDL yearly membership. Direct Allocations are calendar year from January through December and based on the number of students participating in that individual activity.

Old Business

HUDL- request to Casey for a meeting to learn HUDL for all activities. More activities are transitioning to this application and the cost is a good deal due to individual activity membership is \$700 and we cover all activities for around \$2,900 a year. The decision to film an activity is up to each individual head coach/director, they then need to subscribe to the application to create an account for their activity to allow them the ability to upload videos. A few activities already use HUDL including Football and Boys and Girls soccer. HUDL does have the capability to upload video from an ipad.

President's Bowl- Christine reported we are ahead of last year's fundraising but still waiting for some education foundation check for around \$4,500 as well as some sponsorships and Ad sales. The funds raised are around 30% higher than last year with the final raised between \$185,000-\$186,000. This will result in around \$60,000 per school. The school check presentations will occur at basketball games in January and February. RHS Co-chairpersons did an Awesome Job! Thank you Christine and Craig!

Volunteer: Key individuals were unable to attend the discussion around the three activities that are not providing volunteers for the President's bowl and/or Booster club representatives. Discussion will be tabled for next month's meeting- Casey stated due to the transition occurring in his position over the last three years he will relook at this next year for action to take, but discussion can occur as to what that could look like for these activities.

Conference Meal for Teachers- Lance received two "Thank You's" from staff, mentioned that many more should be there due to the overwhelming appreciation by the staff that the meal served from Zaroty's was outstanding.
