- ➤ 1. The Fr/So team concluded their 2016 season with a tough loss to Watertown in the Ken Tomek, Sr. Tournament this past Saturday. Overall, the boys had a very good season, finishing with a record of 13 wins 8 losses and 1 tie. The highlight of their season was a six-game winning streak that included doubleheader sweeps against Harrisburg, Washington, and O'Gorman.
- ➤ 2. The JV has fallen behind the Fr/So and Varsity teams in terms of games played, but they have a very busy week this week to try to catch up. They play one game against Lincoln tonight, two against Harrisburg on Tuesday, and two against Yankton on Thursday. They are currently sitting right at .500 with 7 wins and 7 losses.
- ➤ 3. The Varsity has had a good year so far as they have won 13 games and lost seven. The highlight of the season so far occurred this past Saturday at Ronken Field when the Riders swept #1 ranked Brookings on Senior Day. The Varsity has only two seniors this year, but both of them chipped in big time as Austin Wise picked up the win in game two by pitching the first six innings, and Austin Ryan pitched a perfect seventh to preserve the 5-4 victory. Roosevelt actually trailed 4-0, but rallied to score five runs in the bottom of the sixth to complete an outstanding comeback. The Varsity will play #2 ranked Lincoln tonight, and then they will travel to Yankton to take on the Bucks this Saturday in the Region 2A Tournament. If the Riders can win two games on Saturday, they will play in the State Tournament at Canaries Stadium on Saturday, May 28th.
