 - (1) \$4000 was given to the SCP general fund this month. We are on target to meet our goal of \$24,000 this year.

 - (1) Greg and Laurie have agreed to organize the event for us. Wendy Gehle is helping. Concessions will be organized by Joy, Bev and Julie. This is our largest single event fundraiser.

- (2) We are targeting 60 teams of 5th to 8th grade girls or boys. The event will be held at RHS. **Requesting all parents to recruit teams.** Flyers were available tonight and on the RHS Booster website.
 - (3) Three teams have signed up so far. There are 5 or 6 other tournaments for the same weekend now. If we do not have a lot of teams signed up, we tournament will be one day only.
 - (4) **We still have openings for clock, book and concessions.** Parents and students may sign up. Refs will be paid the going rate.
- iii) Large raffle – Spokesperson: Kelly Wiese 728-1624.
 - (1) We could sell tickets for \$5 each or 3 for \$10. The drawing could be at an event. We could possibly sell tickets at the concession stand. We need to apply for a city permit.
 - iv) South Dakota Quarter Craze – Spokesperson: Candy Molyneux 274-0807.
 - (1) The event was held at the VFW on Monday, 11/7. It was a lot of fun. There was a good turnout. The amount raised is not available yet.
 - (2) We might want to hold another event in the spring.
 - v) Other potential fundraisers –
 - (1) Pancake Feed – **Spokesperson: Needed.** Typically this is held when we play West River in basketball. This year that will be January 5, 6, 7. We could possibly do it Friday night and Saturday morning. We may have the leftover football supplies. Kim Weihe will call Oscar Simmonsa (Band parent) to possibly organize. Kim Hess will help.
 - (2) 50/50 Raffle – **Spokesperson: Needed.** Jodie told us we need a city permit if we want to leverage a 50/50 raffle this year. We need someone to research this. We need approval from Jennifer.

 - i) Kelly has contacted 200+ businesses door to door for donations. Kelly created a spreadsheet of donations so far. This month \$800 was added to our general fund. Last year \$3365 was raised from Business Donations. Our goal this year is \$3000. East Wing Bowling donated one line of bowling to every graduate.
 - ii) Kelly is requesting **any parent willing to contact some businesses** to call Kelly. He will give you a list to work from. We are also looking for a couple people to help with donation letters and thank you notes. Jodie Berens will help with donation letters.

 - i) T-Shirt update (Aimee Cooper). Update by Cathy Regis.
 - (1) 80 tickets have been sold so far. Students will need a completed consent form and \$10 to purchase their ticket. Their ticket is their unaltered t-shirt. **Take your consent form and money to Cathy Regis.** She will distribute the t-shirts. Students are encouraged to start wearing the t-shirts now as advertisement.
 - (2) Parents may also purchase a t-shirt to wear to promote our event. We suggest wearing them while working at the concession stand and other school events as advertisement.
