

**2012 Senior Class Party**  
**Meeting Minutes – 12/12/11**

- 1) Welcome (Jodie Berens)
  - a) We have four months remaining until the event. Please sign up for a sub-committee if you have not already done so.

- 2) Treasurer Update (Jodie Berens on behalf of Larry Gehle)
  - a) The reconciled checking account balance as of 11/20/11 was \$5,797.45. Money came in from concessions, business donations and t-shirt sales. Not including concessions, the 12/10 basketball tournament earned \$4,046.00. Our expenditures were \$2,190.64 for entertainment reservation and t-shirt purchases.

      - (1) Greg and Laurie organized the event for us. Wendy Gehle helped. Concessions were organized by Joy, Bev and Julie. The event was held on Saturday only.
      - (2) 28 teams participated. Not including concessions, the basketball tournament earned \$4,046.00.
    - iii) Large raffle – Spokesperson: Kelly Wiese 728-1624.
      - (1) It was voted we will have a large raffle this year. Kelly Wiese will order tickets and purchase prize items – iPad, meat bundle, grill. There will also be cash prizes.

- (2) Marla Durfee will coordinate ticket distribution. Tickets will be \$5 each or 3 for \$10. Individuals will be checked out books of tickets. We also hope to sell tickets during RHS sporting events, fine arts events and parent/teacher conferences.

Amy will file for approval from Jennifer. Based on where the budgets are, we anticipate doing several 50/50 raffles at sporting and fine arts events at Roosevelt.

Students are encouraged to start wearing the t-shirts now as advertisement.

      - (4) Student shirts are black. Parent shirts are gray. Both glow in the dark. Original shirt cost \$10. Replacement shirts are \$7.50. We are receiving positive feedback on the admission price of \$10 rather than \$50.
