- Introduce new Activities Director, Steve Moore.
 - Coming to RHS from Watertown
 - Grew up in Beresford
 - Went to USD
 - Hired in Watertown to teach and coach
 - From Watertown went to Rapid City and was head boys basketball coach
 - Worked as Dean of Students and an Assistant Principal while in RC
 - Back to Watertown as Assistant Superintendent and then Athletic Director
 - Has been in education for 27 years
 - Believes it is important to keep kids involved in extracurricular activities
 - Excited about the diversity at RHS
 - Will assume position at RHS June 25

New Business

- Dr. Maher to present information regarding the bond issue.
 - Looking at facility issues
 - District enrollment has grown by 8,825 students since 90's
 - By 2023 enrollment will increase to nearly 25,000 students
 - Last high school built was WHS 25 years ago
 - Most elementary are at or over capacity
 - 4 of 5 middle schools are at or over capacity

- New Tech High is under capacity but rest of high school are over capacity
 - RHS was built for 1800 students, this year 2300
 - Discovery & RF Pettigrew now over 900 students
 - Memorial Middle School is the 6th largest school in SD behind RHS, LHS, WHS, Rapid City Central and Stevens and was built for 1000, this year 1300
- Strategic Plan with task force involves Community Engagement
- Kickoff in August - to Learn, Gather Feedback, Develop Options, Board Decisions and Action
- Timeframe August 2017-September 2018
- Solutions may require redraw of boundaries
- Vote on Bond September 18 - total cost board should spend on all projects is \$190 million
- Approximate annual tax increase for \$185,000 median price home would be \$2 per month
 - 1) NW Quadrant for new high school with plans to open asap - soonest would be fall 2021
 - Sanford donated 35 acres with options for 10 more
 - Looking at couple other land options
 - 2) New middle school in SE Quadrant to open in 2021 or 2022
 - 3) New elementary school by 2024 - no recommended location yet
 - 4) Provide TLC to maintain buildings in district
 - 5) \$40 million in equity projects
 - Look to replace Whittier (almost 100 years old) in current location
 - No money in current bond to rebuild on site but to buy homes in area to use land
 - Want to stay true to core of community
- Fundraising opportunity through Adrenaline with Dave Nelson.
 - New digital aspect instead of physical cards
 - Membership model
 - Nationwide program
 - Works for all activities not just athletics
 - Called "Adrenaline Pro"

- More merchant options for discounts available than on actual cards
 - Merchants in Sioux Falls and statewide
 - 6 month membership for \$25 (\$10 goes to school/activity - \$5 for taxes)
 - If you don't have a Smart Phone you can print coupons
 - Will provide a code in August to try 90 days free
 - No auto renewal
 - Activated with code
 - Will not ask for credit card until ready to purchase
 - With each 6 month membership, you can choose a different activity to benefit
 - Can also choose to "donate" more money with each renewal
- 2018-19 Budget
 - Approved with increases to Student Council for Homecoming, Renaissance, Best Buddies and addition of Student of the Month and Movie License
 - New structure for Boosters includes the Finance Committee being made up of four Lead Booster Reps, in addition to Executive Board.
 - Accepting nominations or volunteers for Finance Committee members
